Public Notaries & Commissioner of Oaths

Appeals are required to be signed in the presence of an authorized notary. This discourages frivolous appeals and prevents appeals from being filed on behalf of individuals fraudulently. You can notarize this form via the suggested methods (not limited to)

Appeal Filing Process

- 1. Individuals file an appeal directly with the **Clerk of the Election Appeal Committee,** and no other individual. With the following requirements:
 - a. Indicated the grounds for appeal
 - b. Evidence that supports the grounds for appeal
 - c. Sworn before a Public Notary or Commissioner of Oaths
 - d. \$100 filing fee
- 2. The Chair of the Election Appeal Committee will confirm receipt of an appeal to appellant(s) within 24 hours
- 3. The Chair of the Election Appeal Committee will review the application to ensure that requirements are met and:
 - a. Confirm that the appeal will be heard; or
 - b. Dismiss the appeal, and provide written reasons
- 4. If an appeal will be heard: the Chair will issue a notice of appeal to all candidates, impacted parties, electoral officer, which includes:
 - a. Date, Time, Location, within time limits required by the FLFN Election Code
 - b. Copy of the appeal
 - c. Mechanisms for which parties can submit their evidence
